Sunshine Report

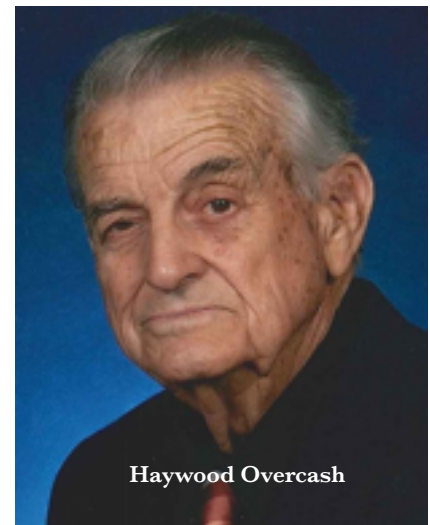
Fellow Airstreamers,
